ATLANTA, Ga. (AP) — egro ministers and civil ghts leaders began a door-door appeal Wednesday ight for calmness to Ne-roes in the area of Tuesday ight's rioting which shat-ered Atlanta's image of ra-

ial harmony.

"We are asking all resi-ents not to allow others to se them as pawns," said tev. Samuel Williams, pres-lent of the Atlanta chapter f the National Association or the Advancement of Col-

red People.

"Atlanta is not by far a serfect city but it is too reat to be destroyed by imple-minded bigotry," he aid, in a summation statement of a two-hour meeting

f civil rights leaders.

Area Tense Several ministers then left o go directly to visit homes in the six-block area near he new sports stadium in an affort to ease the tense situaion.

Earlier in the meeting, everal Negro leaders harged Stokely Carmichael, pational chairman of the stu-lent nonviolent coordinating

committee, with responsibility for the rioting.

"The first thing we've got odo is stop the insurrection," said Rev. William Borders, a grey-haired, long-ime civil rights loader. 'One man is giving us hell.
We've got to stop him before
he stops us.''
