As far as what course would be taken by Dr King it would be his own decision according to Dr. Davis. Dr. Davis further stated that Atlanta is a city that will listen but fail to act. "We have detected an end to progressive action." Dr. Davis stated that if it was necessary to move the head of the Board of Education, Chief of Police or any other office it must be dong so that progressive action might exist.

I talked with Dr. Davis after the conference and he stated that he expected some word from Dr. King within a few hours. Further that Dr. King could be reached in Cleveland, Ohio, at 851-4300, that he felt sure that some action would be taken by Dr. King determined from their conversation. No reason was given as to why Mr. Hosea Williams failed to attend the conference.

The conference ended at 3:05 PM.
