

**APPLICATION FOR AND ORDER
GRANTING CHARTER**
To The Superior Court of said
County, Fulton County, Georgia.

The petition of Q. V. Williamson,
855 Hunter Street, N. W., W. L. Cal-
loway, 193 Auburn Avenue, N. E.,
and C. C. Thornton, 885 Hunter
Street, S. W., all of Atlanta, Geor-
gia, respectfully shows for them-
selves, their associates, successors
and assigns to be incorporated un-
der the name and style of
WITHECA, INC.

1. Petitioners desire for them-
selves, their associates, successors
and assigns to be incorporated un-
der the name and style of
WITHECA, INC.
for a period of thirty-five (35)
years, with the privilege of renewal
as provided by law.

2. The principal office of the cor-
poration shall be in Atlanta, Fulton
County, Georgia, with the right,
however, to establish branch offices
and places of business both within
and without the State of Georgia.

3. The object of this corporation
shall be pecuniary gain to the stock-
holders.

4. The general nature of the
business to be conducted shall be
the buying, selling, leasing, renting,
owning, improving, developing, man-
aging and otherwise dealing in real
property and interest in real prop-
erty.

5. In addition to, but not in limi-
tation of the general powers con-
ferred by law, the corporation de-
sires the power to extend credit, to
lend money, to buy, sell, own and
hold for investment, and otherwise
deal in properties of every kind and
description, both real and personal.

6. Petitioners further desire that
said corporation be vested with all
the rights and powers now and here-
after given to do any and all things
which may be needed or proper in
the operation of the above described
business, and that said corporation
have all of the powers enumerated
in Title 22 of the Georgia Civil
Code of 1933, as amended, together
with such powers as may here-
after be given to similar corpora-
tions by law.

7. The capital stock of said cor-
poration shall be Fifty Thousand
(\$50,000.00) Dollars, divided into
Five Thousand (5,000) shares of
Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per share. The
amount of capital with which said
corporation shall begin business
shall not be less than Two Hundred
(\$200.00) Dollars.

Wherefore petitioners pray that
they be incorporated under the
name and style aforesaid, to be
granted a corporate charter with all
rights, powers and privileges herein
set forth, together with all such
other rights, powers, privileges and
immunities as are allowed by law.
