Council Makes Recommendation On Schools

This was the scene at West Hunter Street Baptist Church Monday evening at a meeting of the Education Sub-Committee, Citizens Central Advisory Council of EOA, Public School Deputy Superintendent Dr. Hilliard A. Bowen thumbs through a list of recommendations the Council made to the Board of Education.

Among the 12 recommendations were that the Board establish a central information center to which all agencies with disadvantaged clients may report needy families eligible for free lunches for their children, that the Board make "a concrete response on the implementation of the Mechanicsville absenteeism proposal, that provisions be made for another school to relieve Herndon, that portable units at Bryant and Herndon be removed, that ROTC be an elective course, that techniques of teaching in low income schools be revamped and that the Board issue a statement on the sources of money spent on the public schools and where the money goes.
