



So We Are a City of Law and Order?

ON TUESDAY, trouble came to Summerhill, near the Atlanta Stadium. Police shot a man in an arrest. The Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee then seized

the opportunity to whip tempers and frustrations to an explosive point. In the danger-filled hours that followed, hundreds of Negroes gathered and many attacked the police with stones, sticks and bottles.

Our riot, even so, was limited. The next day, property damage was seen to be light. As dangerous as the situation had been, only a small number of about 30,000 people who live in slum conditions close to the stadium had been involved.

No one who had bothered to look into Atlanta slum conditions was surprised much by the event or the location. Summerhill and the adjacent neighborhood of Mechanicsville long since had been pinpointed as among our worst slums.

The Community Council of the Atlanta Area told us last February how bad conditions are there. (And how much has been done since then?)

"MUCH of the housing . . . around the stadium is beyond repair, and the interviewers could find very few cases of even minimal maintenance," the report said. "As if in deliberate harmony with housing conditions, the streets commonly have broken pavement and holes; many are not paved at all. Sidewalks are broken and uneven and, with occasional exceptions, grass is nonexistent. At night, the absence of street lights makes the area very dark and dangerous. . . .

"This deterioration has been accentuated through clearance by reducing the available low-income housing units . . ."

Why does Summerhill exist, then?

MOST OF THE area has passed the point of rehabilitation. So Summerhill has been designated for a future urban renewal site. Certainly that will not solve all or even the main problems of those who live there, but done properly and accompanied by the right moves for the people now there, it would relieve many of the conditions.

Why hasn't urban renewal begun? Summerhill is one of eight areas proposed for urban renewal — eight in which Atlanta has not moved because it would not raise the money for the task.

Most of the cost of these renewal operations would be paid by the federal government; but Atlanta has not been willing to spend the money. The city government has not had it; and no one has insisted that it be done. When we have bond issues for urban renewal, the amounts proposed and approved are pittances in comparison with the need.

What happens in the meantime in such an area—Summer-hill, Mechanicsville, Vine City or Plunkettown? What happens is that the city simply does not do its job. Why is the housing code not fully enforced? How can it be done, some officials ask in reply, when houses already are too dilapidated to be re-habilitated, or why should it be done when an area already has been proposed for urban renewal and perhaps already has been zoned for future industrial use? So it goes.

WE ARE HEARING a lot about the law. After a riot, everybody talks about law and order. Those believed to have provoked crowds into violent action are hustled off to jail, charged with inciting to riot, put under bonds totaling thousands of dollars each.

The prosecution of anyone really guilty of inciting alreadywretched people into eating tear gas and otherwise increasing their wretchedness, knowing that this kind of demagoguery puts murder in the air, is absolutely right.

Yet it is interesting to compare what is happening on that front with what happens regularly to the witecollar landlords who fatten themselves on the misery of the slum dwellers.

How many major slum landlords of the kind who make a habit of defying the law and refusing to abide by the city housing code, adding to the bitterness that comes to violence—how many of them currently are in jail serving time or awaiting trial under \$10,000 bond?

None.

EVEN WHEN THE city takes them to court, what does the Housing Court of Atlanta do? Here is what it can do: It can fine a violator \$500 and send him to jail for six months, and if there are 20 cases against him it can repeat that penalty in each. And here is what, by contrast, the Housing Court commonly does do: It fines a mass violator \$22 or \$27, or \$50 and a suspended sentence. It is a bargain.


Even this is only after tenacious evasion of the law; no one is brought into Housing Court except as a last resort.

In Atlanta, as in most big cities, we do not seem to be able to enforce laws against those who illegally profit from the misery of the slums, and who create the conditions that give us violence.

But we surely can be effective in enforcing the law against the trouble-makers. We are a city of law and order.

Rioting In Atlanta

The most surprising thing about the riot in Atlanta is that it should have happened there. For Atlanta, by general agreement, has been a model for southern cities in its race relations.

Mayor Ivan Allen Jr. has walked the last mile in search of racial peace. He had almost solid Negro support when elected. He was one of the few southerners to testify in support of the 1964 civil rights bill. He has added Negroes to the police force. Atlanta's schools and city facilities are totally integrated. Many Negroes are employed by business establishments and the city has sent eight Negroes to the state legislature.

All of this counted for nothing, however, when a suspected Negro car thief was wounded while trying to escape from arresting police officers. When some 500 or more Negroes took to the streets the mayor climbed on top of an automobile and tried to reason with them. He was shouted down. Taunts of "white devil" and "black power" greeted him. Finally the mob surged around the car and the mayor was jarred loose from his perch and fell to the street.

No, this didn't happen in a Birm-

ingham or a Selma. It happened in Atlanta. Little wonder that the Rev. Martin Luther King Sr., who lives in Atlanta, was heard to ask: "What do they want? The mayor came down. He tried to speak to them and they wouldn't listen. What do they want?"

It was a good question, but hard to answer. For most of the members of the mob may not have known themselves what they wanted—unless it was an excuse to throw rocks and rant about police brutality.

The mayor says the riot was deliberately caused by some of Stokely Carmichael's SNCC henchmen, and he may be right. For the mob began shouting "kill the white cops" after SNCC representatives, according to the police, spread the false word that the suspected car thief "had been shot while handcuffed and that he was murdered."

Whatever may have been the case with the rioters, it seems clear that what the SNCC people want is trouble, trouble, trouble, trouble, trouble. And that is what they are going to get, though not in the forthey want, if this sort of madness keeping.







ATLANTA (UP) — Reports another mob was forming sent a police emergency squad rushing into Atlanta's riottorn Negro district yesterday. Officers broke up a group of about 100 persons and arrested 10 who refused to disperse.

Some of the Negroes had "black power" emblems pasted on their shirts, proclaiming: "We're the greatest."

The 10 persons taken into custody were loaded into two police wagons for the trip to jail. Unlike Tuesday, when Negroes tried to overturn the police vans, there was no attempt to interfere with the arrests.

After the brief flurry of excitement, the riot squad — armed with shotguns, tear gas and submachine guns—withdrew to the edge of the Negro area, known as the Summerhill section, but remained on standby.

Mustering point for the city's forces was the parking lot of the new Atlanta baseball stadium, where the city set up a refreshment stand for officers, many of whom have had very little sleep since the rioting erupted Tuesday.

GOVERNMENT BY BLACKJACK

How do you do, ladies and gentlemen. I am your CAPITOL REPORTER, former U. S. Representative, Donald L. Jackson, prepared here with Broadcast No. 112, GOVERNMENT BY BLACKJACK. The power to tax has been called the power to destroy. It is equally true in this day of heavy federal taxation and lavish government handouts, that the power to withhold federal funds from a lower echelon of government is the power to render cities, counties and states impotent to conduct their essential work at the local levels of government. To make complete the dependance of local government upon the central federal power, it is essential to break down traditional governmental groupments by superimposing upon municipal and county governments a form of superior government at the grass roots level of America. We'll return to the blackjack wrapped in a money bag after a brief message.

"LEAST GOVERNMENT THE BEST GOVERNMENT" Thos. Jefferson

Historically, and as a result of prolonged debate in the Constitutional convention, the people of America have been charged with self-rule. To insure that government would not revert to the forms from which the framers of the constitution had themselves escaped, only certain and limited powers were assigned to the Federal agency, with all others specifically reserved in Article 10 to the states and to the people.

This reservation of powers was not capricious. It evolved as the product of personal experience. Eighteenth Century America and the men who forged the Constitution of the United States carried on their work ever mindful of the conditions and circumstances which had forced an exodus from the relative security of the Old World to the forbidding and hostile shores of the New. Uppermost in the minds of the men who labored to frame a unique, and in fact, heretical blueprint for Government, was the certain knowedge that powerful central authority and freedom from the individual could not co-exist.

CONSTANT CHECK

The Government most responsive to the will of the people is that form in which elected or appointed officials are close enough to those they represent to sense, almost instinctively, shifts in public temper and opinion. The essence of the Republican form is that those citizens who are selected by other citizens for public service must estab-

lish and maintain a rapport with the constituent element if service is to be meaningful. Anything that tends to isolate public servants from those they represent at subordinate levels of government, paves the way for the accretion of additional and dangerous powers in higher echelons. The greatest protection enjoyed by a free people are public officials immediately available for the redress of grievance. City councilmen, mayors, supervisors, selectmen and other municipal officers elected to serve in clearly defined areas, and charged with specific duties for which they are personally responsible, constitute the best examples of the Republican form in practice. Sins of commission or omission can be pin-pointed where responsibility is fixed and where there are no grey areas of overlapping jurisdiction.

REGIONAL PLANNING

Under various guises, and using federal funds as a lever to force compliance, the federal establishment has embarked upon a series of programs designed to "regionalize" large areas without regard to existing geographic boundaries. One of these undertakings is called "Metropolitan Government". Stated simply, Metropolitan Government means the superimposition of a New administrative agency over an entire area or region. Metropolitan Government may be restricted to a relatively small area, or it may encompass a number of communities or municipal corporations. The problems peculiar to one area in the Metropolitan complex thus becomes a general problem of all units. It follows that official responsibility for the proper discharge of the duties incumbent upon a municipal officer becomes difficult if not impossible to fix with scores or perhaps hundreds of local and federal office holders and appointees, involved. The vital element of personal rapport becomes the first casualty to planned confusion parading as "Metropolitan Government."

LOS ANGELES PLAN

Under continuing and growing federal pressure, coupled with a threat to reduce or cut off federal money for other projects, the Los Angeles City Council is presently grappling with a program called SCAG - S.C.A.G. SCAG, or the Southern California Association of Governments, is a typical example of federal intrusion into the affairs of the people, an intrusion specifically prohibited by the Constitution. The program, presented by the planners as a device by which future federal intervention may be avoided, is clearly the product of Great Society planning in the area of urban affairs. If more proof is required to establish the intensity of Washington in a matter of this kind one need go no further than the words of Mr. Calvin Hamilton, master planner for the City of Los Angeles. On November 10th, Mr. Hamilton said, in part, and I quote:

"The Federal Government has made it clear that they will not grant any money or federal funds to open space until there is a regional planning program.....if the city is to receive any federal funds, we must join SCAG."

A COUNTRY OF REGIONS

Mr. Hamilton's phrase "regional planning" emphasizes the intent of Great Society planners to compartment the nation into a number of "regions", each of which must, under the provisions of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, prepare and submit to Washington, D. C. a comprehensive "master plan" for the region. The plan, and again we stress, without the suggestion of constitutional authority, must be approved in Washington

by the architects of the Great Society, and the agents and officials who accompany the federal money to the region where it is to be disbursed, will, of course, be empowered to override and to veto any local proposal at variance with the approved blueprint. You can get in to talk with your councilman now, but I suggest that getting an appointment with the Secretary of Commerce or with any of his agents who will exercise final control over "regional" matters will be considerably more difficult.

MAKEUP OF SCAG

The proposed organization of SCAG (and any of you viewers and listeners may awaken one day to find SCAG's blood-brother on the doorstep) reminds one of the elements which comprise the United Nations - the Security Council and the General Assembly. The "General Assembly" organization would include delegates from six Southern California counties, and from each of 142 cities in those counties wishing to affiliate. Los Angeles County, as the most populous of the counties involved, would carry a proportionate share of the non-federal financial load. The "Security Council", so to speak, would be composed of one delegate from each of six cities in the participating counties; 1 Supervisor from each county; and a permanent delegate from Los Angeles, presumably the Mayor of that city. If you find this whole thing a little difficult to grasp, ladies and gentlemen, don't despair. You have plenty of company!

VOLUNTARY COOPERATION . . . OR ELSE!

The advocates of such regional undertakings as Metropolitan Government, SCAG, Urban Renewal, and other federally-initiated and subsidized undertakings, point out the all-too-obvious complexities confronting local subdivisions of government. Admittedly, population explosion, mass migration of people, diminished tax revenues at the municipal and county levels of government have rendered infinitely more difficult the administration of the public business. Add to these difficulties the unconcealed threat of a cut-off of federal funds unless local officials acquiesce in the demands of the federal planners, and what sometimes appears a willingness on the part of harassed office holders to jump on the federal band-wagon becomes somewhat clearer. It is not so much that the problems confronting our people are impossible of solution at the grass roots, however. Left to their own devices, free to exercise their own initiative. Americans have always demonstrated a unique capacity for landing on their feet following a social, political or economic dislocation or explosion. It is only when they are shackled, herded, blackjacked into compliance with orders from on high that their native judgments become confused and their traditional self-reliance falters. Mr. and Mrs. John America are, first of all, individualists. When something goes wrong, when taxes soar out of sight, when they think that money is being wasted, they want someone to talk to. One can corner Mayor Smith or Councilman Brown, but even if one understands what the Great Society is, or is supposed to be, it's hard to get it on the telephone.

SCAG POSTPONED TEMPORARILY

Before some of this Reporter's audience in other areas sees or hears this broadcast, the matter of SCAG will have been decided as far as Southern California is concerned. It is to the credit of the City Council of Los Angeles that they laid the matter aside for a month in order to allow further study of a very involved proposal. It is to be hoped that the threat of a cut-off of other federal money will not be permitted to influence a final and irrevocable decision in the matter. Meanwhile we urge that our listeners in Southern

California communicate their opinions to their own mayors and city councilmen, with a reminder that they are elected to tend shop in their own communities and that if a need for regional representation ever develops, space can be provided on election ballots to accomposate the names of candidates for those positions. This great country isn't a gridded series of "regions" or "areas". Much has been said and written about the mainstream of American life, what it is, what it comprises, and where it is moving. Without laboring these questions, ladies and gentlemen, I would suggest that its source is in the legislative chambers of city and town halls from coast to coast. For it is there that our people speak with authority and with a purpose born of familiarity with their peculiar and non-"regional" problems. Federal money IS important, but even more important is the citizen's right to confront personally his elected representatives and demand an accounting of offical acts. This will be lost to you - and to you - and to you - when your address becomes John Doe, Federal Region #9, Redevelopment District #4, Portland Area 8, Zip Code 99999. Remember, ladies and gentlemen, the "least government" is still "the best government".

What Negroes Really Want

In all the furor in recent years over rights for Negroes, little real effort has ever been made to determine exactly what the Negro-in-the-home really wants. "Freedom Now" has been the rallying cry, instant prosperity the indication. But the precise details have been lacking.

Now a survey conducted for the Senate subcommittee on executive reorganization—the one which has been conducting hearings on the plight of the cities—has made a stab at finding out what the average Negro family really wants. And the answers are not very surprising, though Martin Luther King and Stokely Carmichael probably don't like them.

THE SUBCOMMITTEE'S survey,, conducted by the John F. Kraft firm, revealed that the Negro in the "ghetto":

✓ Isn't particularly interested in civil rights laws;

Loathes welfare programs because they force families to break up;

Isn't worried about "police brutality" because he lives in a state of near-anarchy, and actually wants more police protection;

Rejects forced desegregation of schools, but wants schools that will teach children basic discipline, manners and personal hygiene.

Senator Abraham Ribicoff, chairman of the subcommittee, said the survey was conducted in carefully-controlled interviews in Watts, Harlem, Chicago and Baltimore, using especially-trained Negro interviewers to overcome the "whitey" barrier.

THE SLUM AREA Negro's objection to welfare programs is that family instability is one of the prime causes of difficulties among the poorer Negroes. But where an unskilled Negro father finds it difficult to support his family, welfare pro-

grams help out only if he breaks away from his family. What the Negroes of the slums want, the surveyors report, is job training so they can get off relief and keep the family together.

HARLEM RESIDENTS were particularly strong in their demand for stopping crime on the streets. Whole neighborhoods, the surveyors reported, have been virtually abandoned to dope addicts ready to kill, maim or steal for a "fix." The Negroes want more police protection, so they can walk, shop, work and live in safety.

The results of this survey speak well for the Negro families of the big city slums, for they show that the aspirations of the average Negro there are sound and in keeping with the aspirations of most other Americans. But the survey findings suggest that the civil rights leaders and the political liberals are chasing the wrong moonbeams.

INSTEAD OF laws and court decisions liberalizing the protection of the individual Negro from the brutal arm of law enforcement, the Negroes want more police protection.

Instead of laws and "guidelines" forcing an arbitrary quota-system integration in schools, the Negroes want better education and stricter discipline in their community schools.

Instead of a dole and a poverty war, the Negro wants to learn job skills with which he can support himself and his family.

Instead of government programs to take over his children as toddlers, the Negro wants an opportunity to support and rear them himself.

The survey is a mighty good start-

The survey is a mighty good starting place for some re-thinking by all of us—from private citizen to public official to Negro "leaders." There may not be as much politics in the changed emphasis. But there would be a lot more common sense and potential.



SUBVERTING NEGRO CHURCHES

Created doubt, lack of confidence, suspicion; setting up situations that bring about racial bitterness, violence and conflict; putting forth demands so unrealistic that race relations are worsened; attacking everybody in disagreement as reactionaries, fascists, Ku Kluxers among whites and Uncle Toms among Negroes, constitute the red's pattern of operation.

Fortunately, the overwhelming majority of Negroes, in whose name the Communists and their ilk presume to speak, have not fallen for the blandishments of the Reds. They know a red light when they see one. The same cannot be said of many Negro intellectuals carrying the ball for Communists. Since the Communists have always looked upon Negro intellectuals as "shallow," "superficial," "phrasemongers" and "incompetents" "looking for a loaf when they, on a basis of ability, are not worthy of a crumb," their pro-communist behavior becomes all the more tragic and ludicrous.

Only after the order came from Moscow in the 1934-35 period to win over the Negro intellectual by deceptive flattery and adulation did the red's public attitude toward them change. The Kremlin concluded that these "superficial phonies" could serve the cause of Communism.

A large number of Negro ministers are all for the Communists. Some are prominent and influential; others are "run of the mill." They in common believe that beating the racial drums is a short cut to prominence, money and the realization of personal ambitions even if the Negro masses are left prostrate and bleeding--expendables in the mad scramble for power.

Abner W. Berry, columnist in <u>The Daily Worker</u>, official organ of the Communist Party, recently praised they ministers as fulfilling their "historic role," i.e., delivering the Negro into the hands of the Communists. Neither his pen nor his lips had such praise prior to the 1934-35 period. Then the Moscow line was clear.

The resolution on the Negro Question stated:

"In the work among the Negroes, special attention should be paid to the role played by the churches and preachers who are acting on behalf of American imperialism. The Party must conduct a continuous and carefully worked out campaign among the Negro masses, sharpened primarily against the preachers and the churchmen, who are the agents of the oppressors of the Negro race."

"The Council's views were presented in a statement which was adopted by a vote of 23 in favor, 10 opposed, and six absentions, at the conference in ladison, Misconsin. It is the first statement on the Vietnam war to be made by a major V.S. religious body..."

A False View of the Problem

The MCC's general board's statement, which drew feature attention in the official newspaper of the U.S. section of the international communist conspiracy, exhibited a strange view of our nations resistance to communist aggression and terror in South Viet Nam. According to an AP news item in The Tulsa Tribune of December 3, the MCC's statement warned that our policy of resistance to communist terror and aggression in Viet Nam could not result in a victory which would "compensate for the distrust and hatred throughout the United States that is being generated" because of our "overwhelming military strength to kill more find more and more dark-skinned Asians."

In view of such an oversimplification and false concept of the Viet Nam problem, it is obvious that the MCC group would favor our nation's bowing to the communists' demand to get out of Wiet Name However, it mid but a condition on such proposed withdrawal. "The SNCC (Student Mon-Violent Co-Ordinating Committee plans to precipitate a crisis in Mississippi of such magnitude that the Federal Government will have to take over the State, the organization's 23 year old national chairman said here yesterday. The method will be to "saturate" the State with volunteer voter-registration workers from the Nation's college campuses 'on a given day or week' early next summer, John Lewis said.

"This, he anticipates, will result in 'hundreds of thousands' of Negroes 'standing in the voter registration places all over the State at one time .. ' That in turn will cause mass arrests -- maybe 75,000 people in the Mississippi jails -- a situation Lewis figures it will be impossible for the Federal government to ignore

"Lewis conceded that there is 'bound to be some kind of conflect, some kind of violence, arising from the Student Non-Violent Co-ordinating Committee's plan. "We hope it won't happen," he said, 'but from past experience it probably will. But the possibility of violence is justified, he said, because 'out of this conflict, this division and chaos, will come something positive. ... of course, a complete take over of the South by the Federal Government, as suggested by John Lewis, is one of the goals for which the communist conspirators have been agitating during the past several years.

SNCC AND THE BLOC VOTE

QUEST FOR MAYS TO HELP THE MEGRO AND HIS COMMUNITY

City officials are under attack by hoodlums who claim they are interested in the upgrading of the Negro. Poverty funds are being wasted to rehabilitate the Negro community, it is being told. Delipidated buildings and buildings vandalized by Negroes are being torn down.

It is felt that this program is missing the entire boat. Windows are smashed out of public school in the Negro community just for the fun of it. In some of the schools all of the windows are smashed out on the entire side. In other schools hundreds of windows were smashed out. Last year the school system spent over \$40,000 just replacing windows. This \$40,000 could have been used to buy new books or to increase the quality of education of schools in the Negro community.

There must be a crash educational program directed at the adults to improve the respect of family, love and respect for community, and respect for school and public property. Many of the dilapidated buildings are in bad shape. This is encouraged by the Civil Rights hoodlums. Many of the Negroes will go onto private property, call cameramen and newspapermen, and have their pictures taken in the buildings. They even bring children into the building. This is a terrible thing. Trespassing on private property to get pictures taken, and claiming they are attempting to clean up the neighborhood, while the very Negroes are shouting about tearing down the dilapidated buildings.

Many mysterious fires occured in this city. Many members of this same group petitioned Mayor Kowal to tear down these buildings, and when they lost their petition in the Supreme Court, the fires mysteriously started each and every night; many of them. The fire truck had to patrol the Negro community to be on hand when the fire started. This resulted in insurance companies cancelling Negro insurance policies for homes and furniture. The Negroes complained to the Governor for investigation of insurance companies to find the reason behind cancellation. Everyone knows that insurance companies do not insure bad risks.

Poverty Funds Finance Violence-Preaching Racial Agitator

In 1965 the Office of Economic Opportunity gave Harlem Youth Opportunities Unlimited-Associated Community Teams (HARYOU-ACT) \$40,000 to be used by the Harlem Black Arts Repertory Theater-School. The head of this theater-school is LeRoi Jones, a Negro playwright who hates whites and stages dramas for young actors in which violence and revenge against "whites" are the main elements.

According to an Associated Press story by Hollie West on December 2, 1965, Jones is quoted as stating, "I don't see anything wrong with hating white people. Harlem must be taken from the beast and gain its sovereignty as a black nation."

LeRoi Jones once wrote, "The force we want is of 20 million spooks (Negroes) storming America with furious cries and unstoppable weapons. We want actual actual brutality."

An editorial in the SHREVEPORT (La) TIMES, of December 18, 1965, revealed that the Office of Economic Opportunity defended the gift of \$40,000 of U.S. taxpayers' funds to the white-hating Negro, LeRoi Jones, by stating: "He is a legitimate playwright--whatever you may think of his views. We knew about it and we granted the money, and we have no apologies."

A cache of arms ranging from the slingshot to a sawed-off rifle were discovered by police in the Black Arts Repertory Theater, according to an AP dispatch of March 17, 1966.

Dr. Douglass has appeared on both the Huntley-Brinkley and Malter Cronkite TV shows on which he discussed his anti-Communist activities.

All the instructions from Moscow at the time ordered reds to "combat the influence of the church" because the church, "by offering to the Negro worker and peasant for the miseries they are enduring in this world, compensation in heaven, are befogging the minds of the Negro workers and peasants, making them a helpless prey to capitalism and imperialism."

The public denunciation of Negro "sky pilots" (A cynical Communist name for clergy) was likewise stopped on orders from Moscow. The election of Julian 3 and to the Georgia State House of Representatives in the Movember 1955 elections is a good example of what can happen through the power of an unthinking bloc vote. Citizens of Mississippi have been warned to expect a bloody assault upon their state this summer by the National Council of Churches, the World Council of Churches, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Student Non-Violent Co-ordinating Committee and other integrationist, race agitating groups.

The National Council of Churches has announced it will send a "task force" of men and money into the Mississippi Delta to wage war on what it describes as "persistent" poverty and racial injustice. The Delta project will call for a tentative annual budget of \$250,000 with the National Council paying for 60 percent of the cost and the World Council picking up the tab for the remaining 40 percent. Officials of the National Council of Churches are entering into this project with the frank acknowledgment that they expect to become involved-on the Negroes' side-in clashes between white and Negro residents of Mississippi.

Complementing this racial agitation will be what
The Harvard Crimson - Harvard University's daily
newspaper-has described as an invasion by militant young E
Negroes of the NAACP and SNCC. In its issue of March
11, The Crimson attributes to Claude Weaver, SNCC
worker and Harvard student recently released from jail
in Jackson, a statement that "Negroes might start
killing the White people in Mississippi pretty soon."

"Yes," Weaver is quoted as saying, "if we wanted to get a small Mau Mau going, it wouldn't be difficult... Might be a nice summer project."

In an editorial of March 12, The Crimson speculates upon the coming invasion of Mississippi as follows:

"This summer will witness a massive daring, probably bloody, assault on the racial barriers of Mississippi..

"The 1964 plan ... calls for an invasion of over 1,000 Peace-Corps- type volunteers,' in order to 'shake Mississippi out of the Middle Ages.'"

So there you have it. There is the explanation of why the National Council of Churches is lobbying along-side the NAACP for passage of the infamous civil rights bill in the senate.

We came through the drepression of the thirties together, sharing what we had, poor as hell could make us, never enough to eat, wearing clothes that were worn out 2 years before, but with never any ill-will toward one another. When times got better, we kept the respect we had earned from each other, and relations were peaceful. Negro and white workers receive the same weekly wage and some cases the Negro is now receiving the larger ware. Negro and White workers at the Bag ett Trans. Co. earn 127. weekly. The older Negroes of the com unity is concerned about the state of affairs as they now exist. He is willing to work and earn his way, but the younger crowd has fallen for the free hand out. Ninety per cent is enrolled in some sort of welfare plan . It looks like the next crop of Booker T. Washingtons and George Washington Carvers is going to be mighty thin. Negroes and hite people have always selected their friends and associates and have gotten along just fine. Race relations will worsen as long as pro-Communists agitators are on loose like Dr. Martin Luther King and cheap politicans exploiting the racial problems for political gains.

Berkeley, Cal., Oct. 16-- A mimeographed sheet is being circulated a mong students at the University of California at Berkeley telling them how to dodge

military service, it was learned today.

The tracts, titled "Brief Notes on the Ways and Means of 'Beating ' and Defending the Draft," were being distributed by leftist groups in connection with the demonstrations against American policy in Viet Nam. The sheets also were found on a desk, for anybody to pick up, near Sproul hall, the administration building.

Text of Pamphlet
The text of the pamphlets follows:

"1. Be a C.O. (Conciencious Objector). Write your local draft board requesting the special conciencious objector form SSS-150. Now if you don't have religious or philosophical reasons that cause you to be against war "in any form" don't let it bother you. Mark "yes" on that question anyway, or markout the "in any form" if you want to be more honest about it.

It is fairly certain that your local board will turn you down. However, you can then appeal their decision, be investigated, appeal again and so on. The whole process takes about a year and by that time we will have stopped the war in Viet Nam. For further information on the C. O. process write: Central Committe for Congiencious Objectors, 2006 Walnut St., Philadelphia, Pa., Code 19103, or: war Resistors League, 5 Beakman Street, New York 38, New York. Have fun.

"How to Get 4-F"

Tell them what army life and the war in Viet Nam are really about. Be determined. The officers will be only too glad to get rid of you.

3. Refuse to sign the loyalty oath and don't mark the med list. If you do, they will arrest you. They'll investigate you and if you have been fairly active in any of the "subversive campus movements, they won't want you.

Play Homosexual Bit

4. Be "gay." Play the homosexual bit. Mark "yes" or don't mark the "homosexual tendencies" line on forms. Psychiatrists may give you the run around, but stick with it. If you are really game, be obviously one of the "gay" boys. Besides flicking your wrist, move your body like chicks do. Hold cigaret delicately, talk melodically, act embarrased in front of the other guys when you undress.

5. Note from doctor. If you have a "friendly" family doctor or can buy one, you'll find he's extremely handy. Get a signed note from him attesting to an allergy, a trick knee or elbow or shoulder or back trouble or asthema. Don't don't forget to mark appropriate places on induction forms and you've got it made. Without a doctor's note, you'll have to a pretty good job of faking these things. 


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

King Links Race Hatred To Low Income Whites

King said these whites "have grown up believing in certain stereotypes, whether it is the stereotype of the Negroes as lazy, or inherently inferior, or whether it is the myth that Negroes depreciate property values when they move into a com-munity."

King appeared yesterday with five other Negroes prominent in civil rights affairs on a special "Meet the Press,, program on NBC radio and television. He took part in the program

dio, leaving before it ended to lead another open-housing lead another open-housing march in Chicago. The other the panelists were in a Washington studio.

'Latent Hostilities'

The Chicago demonstrations, the King said, have brought the open "many latent hostilities already existing within certain white groups in the North."

Asked whether perhaps the majority of white people in the nation don't want a Negro for a neighbor, the rights leader agreed there are some whites against open housing. But he added that "this does not mean that we don't go all out to end housing discrimination."

He said that in the south, whites opposed integrating lunch counters and motels but that this did not prevent passage of civil rights legislation to bar segregation. "The same thing must happen in housing,"

"When the law makes it clear, and is vigorously enforced, we will see that people will not only adjust but... attitudes will also change."

Others on the program included James H. Meredith, who became the first known Negro at the University of Mississippi and was shot from ambush on a voter registration drive in Misell, sissippi last June.

Vigilantes Proposed

During questioning, Meredith advocated organizing vigilante groups to hunt down untried killers of Negroes. Asked if he meant that Negroes should "take the law into their own

"Nonviolence is incompatible thern whites of a "massive out- with American ideas," he added. "This is a military-minded nation."

Meredith said Negroes "cannot continue to tolerate this. If the law doesn't take these men then we got to stop this."

Later he said, however, that "the Negro has never entertained the idea of taking up arms against (all) the whites."

The other panelists were Stoky Carmichael, chairman of the Student Nonviolent Coordi-nating Committee; Roy Wilkins, executive director of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People; Floyd B. McKissick, director of the Congress of Racial Equality, and Whitney M. Young, Jr., ex-ecutive director of the National Urban League,

The six indicated agreement that what King called the "tragic gulf between promise and ful-filment! for Negroes is growing s worse at some points. In gen-eral, they said, the civil rights movement is not accomplishing enough fast enough.

War Is Attacked

Carmichael again attacked the Viet Nam war, saying Negro soldiers there are black mercena-

"A mercenary is a hired killer and I think that when this counonly chance to a decent living is when you join the Army . . . it's saying to that black man his

only chance to a decent life is to become a hired killer," he said.
"I would not fight in Viet Nam, absolutely not," Carmichael said. "I urge every black man in this country not to fight in Viet Nam."

in Viet Nam."

Wilkins, discussing the future of the civil rights movement, said "progress is being made . . . despite the fact that great masses of people cannot count the difference between today's living and what they had two years ago.

But McKissick disagreed.
"Things have not progressed tremendously for the masses of the people," he said. There has been some progress for some Negroes, he added, but "the average black man in the ghetto has not profited within the last 10 years."

Black Power Defined

McKissick also defined "black power" in terms of six ingredients: "One, political power. Two, economic power. Three, an improved self-image of the black man himself. Four, the black man himself. development of young militant leadership. Five, the enforce-ment of federal laws, abolition of police brutality. Six, the development of a black consumer

Young attacked those employers who say they are willing to hire more Negroes but either none apply or few are qualified. Calling those excuses feeble, he said, "We have in this country in the corporate circles the most executive minds the most imaginated. creative minds, the most imagi-native people. . . Any type of worker they really want to em-ploy or train, they can do it."

The Trials of Atlanta

UNTIL THIS week, the City of Atlanta had maintained a glowing reputation as one of the hardest-working communities in the building of interracial harmony and progress. Through the efforts and cooperation of whites and Negroes, it established itself as a model of peaceful integration, a model studied by other Southern communities trying to solve their own racial problems.

Then Stokely Carmichael came to town with his inflammatory sales pitch for "black power" and his rantings against "the white devils." And on Tuesday night, Carmichael's loudspeaker campaign came to fruition with the rioting of a mob. This mob attacked the mayor, who tried to reason with its members. It attacked the policemen who tried to restore order. But it did more—it attacked the concept Atlanta has represented, the concept Atlanta has represented, the concept attacked a spirit in which all races can work together to build a better city.

THIS WAS perhaps the greatest damage that the mob did. Now other city fathers may be tempted to shrug their shoulders and say: "What's the use? Atlanta has done as much as any city in the South to make cooperative integration work, and look what happened."

Dallas citizens in particular may be discouraged by Atlanta's experience, for the two cities are very much alike in their populations, in their economies and in their attempts to build through interracial cooperation.

But before we decide to abandon the path that Dallas and Atlanta have tried to follow, it would serve us well to look deeper into the events of the current week. There is more to the story than the headlined activities of Carmichael's SNCC barnstormers or of the hundreds of young rioters.

We should note that there were Negro as well as white leaders who tried, at the risk of their safety, to quell the violence. There were Negro as well as white policemen who skillfully restored order before the riot turned into a bloodbath.

And, perhaps most important, the Negro Atlantans, local civil-rights leaders and ministers, were the ones who organized a door-to-door campaign the following day to counter Carmichael's efforts to turn the city into a battleground.

IN SHORT, in Atlanta, there is a durable fabric of society, a fabric that has been woven of both white and black threads through the years of cooperation. The efforts of these years have not been as dramatic or as well-publicized as the riot, but in the final analysis they should prove to be more lasting in their results.

These results of the work of men of good will will not be destroyed overnight by men of Carmichael's stripe. Rational Atlantans of both races cannot stand by and see their community torn asunder, because those of both races know that they have a stake in its future.

The Rev. Samuel Williams, president of the Atlanta chapter of the NAACP, summed it up most succinctly when he declared:

"Atlanta is not by far a perfect city but it is too great to be destroyed by simpleminded bigotry." ONI







SNICK Goal: Destruction f Society

Riots Expose Stokely Carmichael And His Organization Of Anarchists

The recent riots in Atlanta offer convincing evidence that most, if not all, of the racial violence in our large cities has been organized and led by a small minority



My authority for this statement is Ralph McGill, publisher of the Atlanta Constitution, and long a moving and militant force for equal treatment of the Negro citizen as provided by law and the Constitution of the United States.

McGill places responsibility the Atlanta disturbance squarely upon the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee. (SNICK) and its leader Stokely Carmichael. SNICK, according to McGill has no more than 300 members. These have been the agents of anarchy in Watts, New York, Chicago, Cleveland and other major cities.

fruits of a compatible society in which there is mutuality of purpose and respect for all.

This nation will not, however, permit the destroyers of society-the Carmichaels and his ranting radicals to tear down what we have built, to burn and destroy, to defy law and order with rocks and Molotov cocktails or to hurl anarchistic slogans and imprecations at our public officials.

The Ribicoffs and the Kennedys who continue to deplore "our tragic conditions" from comfortable seats in the U.S. Senate should visit riot areas and seek to quiet the mob, as did Mayor Allen.

If nothing else, the experience might leave them better informed and not quite so sure that all social ills ·can be cured by dispensing a few hundred more millions from Washington.

SNICK'S beginnings were more auspicious. Its early student leaders were motivated by high dedication to the civil rights cause. Now the John Lewises and other responsibles are out. Control of SNICK is held by the extreme radicals, of which Carmichael is the dominant

As McGill says, SNICK is no longer a civil rights organization but an anarchistic group which is openly and officially committed to the destruction of existing institutions.

Though small in membership, SNICK appeals to all haters of the white man. It's slogans of defiance intrigue the very young as was shown in Atlanta where the mob was largely composed of youngsters in the 12 to 18 age range.

There appears to be no question but that SNICK's p funds are supplied from abroad. One of its lawyers is a registered Castro agent. Its agitators shout Havana lor slogans to the effect that we must live through violence. "Black Power" is but the rallying cry.

Mayor Of Courage

Fortunately for Atlanta, it has a mayor who confronted the mob with rare courage. Though physically manhandled and taunted with shouts of "white devil," Mayor Ivan Allen, Jr., remained upon the scene until the crowd had been dispersed.

Mayor Allen gave short shrift to charges of police brutality. "I saw plenty of brutality," he said, "but it was all directed against police officers." At his press conference, Mayor Allen stated that "If Stokely Carmichael is looking for a battleground, he has created one, and he will be met in whatever situation he chooses." he chooses.

Atlanta's Negro community leaders were quick to decry the rioting and violence. The Atlanta Summit Leadership Conference, a Negro organization, denounced both SNICK and Carmichael, while calling for construc-tive measures designed to alleviate problems which directly concern the Negro.

Dr. Martin Luther King, executive director Roy Wil-kins of the NAACP and Whitney Young who heads the Urban League have all repudiated Stokely Carmichael and his tactics.

A Useful Service

The city of Atlanta has long enjoyed an enviable reputation for racial amity. Ironically, it was Atlanta's splendid image that the destroyers sought to tarnish.

And yet, unwittingly, Stokely Carmichael and his followers performed a useful service not only for Atlanta but for the entire nation.

For here was stripped away the myth that Negroes are always incited to riot over poor living conditions, lack of employment and denial of civil rights.

Mr. Carmichael has now revealed himself for what he is - a scheming fomenter of disorder, a mad dog who attacks all whites indiscriminately, a revolutionist who seeks to burn and destroy, a terrorist who defies law and spits upon our flag.

Problems Are Many

The right to peaceable assembly is guaranteed by the Bill of Rights, as is the freedom to demonstrate and to seek redress of grievances.

Together and in a spirit of constructive cooperation, the Negro and white communities must find solutions and answers to the problems which beset our cities. For they are both numerous and difficult.

A major start has been made in many areas. Where failures have occurred, the Negro is usually as much at fault as his white brother. Suspicions, distrust and fear of association have worked against the Negroes' best interests.

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





Congressman James D. Martin of Alabama has inserted in the Congressional Record an interesting column written by Don MacLean of the Washington Daily News on a timely subject. It is the newspaperman's reaction to President Johnson's pointed warning that riots might erupt in Washington if Congress doesn't approve the President's plan to provide political home rule for the District of Columbia. Mr. MacLean wrote:
By now, the President doesn't need the likes of me to tell him how poorly conceived were his remarks about the possibility of a rio here. The editorialists and, I'm sure, his advisers, have already done that. My personal view is that what the President said was the greatest flame - fanning act since Nero and his fiddle at Rome. What I want to do today is (1) tell the President what it is like to live in the mouth of a cannon in the mouth of a cannon and (2) thank him for making it more likely that some nut will pull the trig-

ger.

I live about 30 blocks from the White House, in a neighborhood called Mount neighborhood called Mount Pleasant. (In contrast to many of L. B. J.'s leading liberals, who live safely tucked away in Maryland or Virginia.) There's no ghetto of any kind in Mount Pleasant, not even a white one. I have never had anything but the friendliest relations with my neighbors, be they Negro or white. In short, we are a happy mixture of people who get along just swell. The riots in Los Angeles made all of us nervous, because, in truth, none of us wants any trouble.

HERE'S HOW IT IS

There is a serious rate of violent crime in our area. But it affects everyone equally. The crimes have caused many of us to take precautions. After several attempts were made to break into my house, I surrounded it as best I could with a 6-foot fence. After a girl running from an attacker pounded on my door one night seeking safety, I called the police and the next week bought a gun, I figure that something worse may happen another night, and I want a gun if he has one. My wife suggested watchdogs, and I got two German shepherds.

You don't know it is?

Well, on Saturday night in Mount Pleasant, it is worth your life to walk to the store. An elderly man was killed for \$2 in the bright sunlight, while washing his car. A man was shot out by my mailbox. Many a night we've watched from a second floor window as gangs of men have battled in the alley with boards and pipes. King Gets Shunting

U. S. Sen. James O. Eastland appearing at the Neshoba County Fair here a few days ago, told a large audience that the Negro leader, Martin Luther King, "has not gone over in the North and they are shunting him back South."

The statement came on the heels of announcements that King is bringing his annual convention of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference to Jackson, Aug. 7 - 8.

Sen. Eastland, considered the leading anti - liberal in the Congress, cautioned the citizens of this area to pay as little attention to the rabble - rousings of King as possible.

It has been noted that everywhere that the "non - violent" King goes up north, death and destruction have sprouted.

Sen. Eastland told the Neshoba audience that even liberal solons in Washington "s a w through" the shooting incident of James Meredith several weeks ago, and the result was a break-through for the conservative cause.

"The man with the rifle, an expert marksman according to his military record, called three times for attention of Meredith in order that the cameramen could focus," Eastland noted, "Yes, the North even saw through that, when an expert marksman used birdshot to 'kill.'

So much for the Eastland statement . . . we are attracted to the New York Times via the St. Louis Post Dispatch this week.

GIFTS CUT

The Post Dispatch, quoting the New York paper, reprints the following which should show a turn of affairs up North

The Northern Liberals, fearful of extremism, are cutting back sharply on contributions to the more militant civil rights organizations.

The big drop in donations from the liberal community is verified by top officers and former leaders of the Congress of Racial Equality, the Student nonviolent co-ordinating committee, popularly called Snick, and the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Money from white persons in the past has been the lifeblood of their campaigns.

In a series of interviews, officers of those organizations and civil rights donors gave three that contributions fell significantly after a CORE officer at Mount Vernon, N. Y., denounced Jews in general at a public meeting in February.

Lynch says that about 80 per cent of his group's financial support has come from the white community "and you could say that Jewish contributions have been predominant."

RESIGNATIONS

Former high - ranking national officers of CORE recently resigned but sill in close touch with the situation, say that contributions to it this year are running only little better than half of the \$810,000 total of the previous fiscal year.

Lynch denies such a severe drop but does not disclose the figures. He concedes that the deficit is between \$200,000 and \$250.000. Former CORE leaders put it as high as \$350,000.

Ivanhoe Donaldson, new director of the New York office of Snick, which operates primarily in the South but has frankly depended on white northern financial help, says "our contributions are 40 to 45 per cent less than we normally have at this time of year."

He says that the Student Committee is no longer supported "by those liberal whites who believe in integration in the South but not New York or Chicago."

Today the organization has the help of the radicals, he says. The Student Committee talks of about \$650,000 in income in

the fiscal year 1965.

The Student Committee charges the Northern press with distortions about the meaning of "black power," causing liberals to worry about "racism" and "black nationalism."

and "black nationalism."

The Rev. Dr. King's conference says that 70 per cent of its financial help has come from white liberals but that contributions dropped from \$1,500,000 in the fiscal year 1965 to less than \$1,000,000 in 1966.

There are indications that much money from whites is being shifted from CORE and Snick to more conservative rights groups or to educational and legal defense organizations benefiting the Negro.

SLACKENING INTEREST

Civil Rights leaders and donors report a general slackening in Northern interest after the enactment of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and last year's voting rights law.

Dr. King demands a "militant thrust forward" by Negroes but deplores use of the term "black power" as implying black nationalist ideas. His organization reports contributions down by more than one third in the fiscal year ending. June 30. cal year ending, June 30.

vice president and treasurer of the Leadership Conference, says that "black power" demands and allegedly racist attitudes of CORE and Snick have seriously affected the King organization because many whites do not differentiate among the

He referred to a new all-black party in one Alabama county. Another, Joseph Willen, exec-

utive director of the Federation of Jewish Philanthropies, has switched his support to the Na-tional Urban League and to the scholarship, education and de-fense fund for racial equality, set up friends and staff people of CORE in 1962, but separate operation.

CORE, he says, has apparently decided not to be an interracial group any longer, "and the opposite of that is racist."

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
