Edward Moody called. I located him at Eliza Paschall's office.

He wanted the Mayor to call a meeting immediately with department heads and the Mechanicsville Civic League and tell the department heads and Housing Authority the things that they had to do immediately.

He said they were going to start a campaign to get the McDaniel Housing Project built. They are going to start complaining to the press.

He said they object to the Mayor meeting with the Summit group -- that they never heard of what went on in the meetings and that the Summit Leadership certainly didn't represent them in Mechanicsville.
