

**CARMICHAEL ACCUSED
OF INCITING RIOTS**

**Congressman Hays Calls For
Crackdown On Negro Leader**

WASHINGTON — Rep. Wayne Hays, (D) Ohio, has called for a federal crackdown on Negro leader Stokely Carmichael whom he accused of "inciting riots" in Atlanta, Ga., and Cleveland, Ohio.

Hays told the House:

"Carmichael and his anarchist group belong behind bars and the quicker we get him there the better off this country is going to be."

Both Democrats and Republicans — about 50 in the chamber at the time — applauded after the Belmont county Democrat's brief speech.
