I earnestly request you to use your influence to persuade these negro brokers to abandon their planned attack on our community. I am enclosing an article which appeared in a recent issue of the West End Star. This article sums up the block busting attemps in our community.

I would like to hear of your plans for curbing the unrest which now exists in Southwest Atlanta.
