Dear Mr. Edmunds:

In accordance with the HUD Handbook and Regional Office Memorandum No. 64, we are herewith transmitting five (5) binders of a Part I Amendatory Application to the Urban Renewal Plan and the Loan and Grant Contract for the West End Project.


The purpose of this amendment is to add to acquisition certain parcels determined to be infeasible of rehabilitation, to delete from acquisition certain parcels in order to allow private enterprise maximum opportunity to redevelop the area in a manner consistent with the Urban Renewal Plan, and to change the reuse designation of certain parcels from commercial to high density residential in order to provide needed housing in the area. This amendment also incorporates as a non-cash grant-in-aid certain street widening activities being undertaken by the City of Atlanta on Gordon Street.

This Amendment increases the Total Federal Capital Grant by \$1,070,120 from \$8,767,650 to \$9,837,770 and increases the Project Temporary Loan by \$764,768 from \$11,811,452 to \$12,576,220.

We are confident that this Amendatory Application will receive your earliest consideration to enable the Authority to proceed expeditiously with its redevelopment efforts in West End.
