A RESOLUTION

BY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

where AS, pursuant to a resolution adopted by the Board of Aldermen on March 6, 1967, the City of Atlanta has submitted an application to the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development for a Model Cities planning grant under Title 1 of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act of 1966 and,

WHEREAS, the announcement of those cities which have been chosen to receive such grants was made November 16, 1967 and,

WHEREAS, Atlasta is among those cities choses and,

WHEREAS, it is important that the planning phase of this program be started immediately since this phase is limited to a one year period and,

whereas, in its application the City proposed that the authority and responsibility for administering the planning phase of this program be vested in an Executive Board composed of the Mayor of Atlanta, two members of the Board of Aldermen, the President of the Atlanta School Board, the Chairman of the Fulton County Commission; one member to be appointed by the appearance; and three members to represent the private sector of the community; one from the general public, one from among the City's Negro leadership and one from the Model Neighborhood Area residents.

Aldermen that the Model Neighborhood Executive Board is hereby created for the purpose of administering the planning phase of such program which is conducted under Title I of the Demonstration Cities and Metropolitan Development Act of 1966, commonly known as the Model Cities Program, and for which federal financial assistance is received.
