Dear Tom:

Thank you for your letter of February 1, 1967 and the attached opinion regarding the Cyclorama and its gift to the City.

A search of our records reveal that the last year a .10¢ admission charge was made was 1916. Starting in 1917 the admission fee was increased to .15¢ and has consistently risen over the years to the present cost of \$1.00 for adults and .50¢ for children. Group rates of course are .50¢ for adults and .25¢ for children. Therefore, it appears that for at least 51 years we have been charging in excess of .10¢ per person to see the Cyclorama.

I do not believe I will reply to Mr. Gress' letter unless I hear further from him and if I should I will merely advise him that for 51 years we have been charging fees in excess of .10¢.

Thank you for your obviously very thorough research and trusting we might reciprocate, I am
