Just a note to express our appreciation for your forthright stand in testimony before the Senate Commerce Committee last week. You made it clear, indeed, that a public accomodations law would clarify the situation to a great extent for both businessmen and their publics. But we commend even more your stand on the morality of the issue -- your voicing that there is a right and wrong in this matter, and your willingness to take your stand despite the possible political liabilities.

One dissent: remember what happened in school desegregation because of "all deliberate speed". Any period of grace which might be attached to the legislation must have a definite and not-toodistant compliance date included, or we stand open to witnessing a delaying spectacle like that regarding the schools over the past nine years.
