
Dear Mr. Satterfield:

At the public hearing held by the newly appointed Community Relations Commission on Thursday, February 16 the following matter was reported to the Commission:

Mrs. Charity Murray, 76 Hilliard Street, Apartment 612 (Grady Homes), reported that she has received an eviction notice, effective February 28, following an incident in which a neighbor shot at Mrs. Murray's granddaughter who was visiting her at her apartment. Mrs. Murray was called to court as a witness, but had no charge filed against her. The other person has already moved. Mrs. Murray stated that as far as she knew this was the only reason for her eviction and since she was not at fault she did not understand why she was being evicted. She stated that she had attempted to discuss the matter with Mr. Carl Brown, but had gotten no satisfaction from him. Mrs. Murray lives with her mother who is quite elderly, and she says that she has no money to make a move and does not have the means to afford private housing.

I am sorry that I have not had the time to come and talk with you about my new job as Executive Director of the Commission; I certainly hope to do so soon. For your information enclosed are copies of the Ordinance and membership of the Commission. The Commission will meet Friday, February 24 at 1:30 P.M. and I would like to be able to report to them on Mrs. Murray.
