This letter is not
intended to criticize you
for my wife and I are
former natives of
Delelitz, Laurens Co. Ga.
Altho we along with
hundreds of other white
U.S. Citizens think
that you made some
very bad mistakes
during the other Nigger
uprising in Atlanta
and it is a known
fact that you and a

few more Atlanta officials
 practically gave your
 City to the Negroes and
 according to the news
 reports your intentions
 were to keep down
 racial riots and to
 pacify the Negroes and
 to obtain Negro votes
 which you did, but
 now you are having the
 second riot which was
 intended and has been
 being built up for quite
 a while.

Now we both know
 that there is no such

of a thing as a Peaceful
 Negro Demonstration set
 up by the N.A.A.C.P., CORE,
 S.N.C.C. or any other headed
 by Martin Luther King or
 Stokely Carmichael, they
 are all well plotted and
 planned in advance to
 create racial strife and
 riots and I am certainly
 glad that you have
 woke up to the facts

Also, there is no such
 thing as the black
 and white race war -
 all mixing regardless
 of what the Kennedy

and Johnson Clarke says,
 And as far as the way
 the majority of the
 Negroes live, that is
 just the way they want
 it, and will not have
 any better even if it
 is given them as a
 precious gift which
 the U. S. Gov. is trying
 to do.
