3. The Project Architect will be Bill Finch. He will be the secondary contact, will be co-responsible with the Managing Partner and will represent the firm of Finch, Alexander, Barnes, Rothschild & Paschal.
4. Architectural work will be performed in a special suite of offices at 3033 Maple Drive, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia.
5. This work will be under the direct supervision of R. H. Thompson and a member of FABRAP to be designated as the Job Captain.

You will receive a letter within a few days which will outline the need for a program, what a program is, the time required and the fee involved. We do not anticipate the need for any consultants during the program development phase. As the program is being written, we will consider and decide what consultants will be required for the design of the building.
