I am very glad that you testified as you did before the Commerce Committee in Washington last week.

I am not willing to concede that your testimony in Washington means political suicide. It may be the very thing that will put you over in case you see fit to run for office again. There are many white people in Atlanta who know that you did right but do not have the courage to say so now. I believe it will be different two years from now.

Then too the atmosphere will have so changed in the nation and in Atlanta by 1965 that you will find your statement there all to the good.
