In the 10-year period 1956 - 1966 a total of 20,994 families in Atlanta were dislocated as a result of all governmental action - urban renewal, highway and expressway construction, etc.

In the same period, ^{7,576} ~~6,294~~ units ~~built~~ of public housing were ~~built~~ completed. These included:

4,347 units single family low income 221-D-2

1,359 units ~~single family~~ moderate income 221-D-3

1,870 units ^{low income} Public Housing (Atlanta Housing Authority)

In addition to ~~the~~ completed public housing, the following units are under construction, out on bid, planned or on reservation:
