him financially will
make him a Millionaire
if he is not now.

In the demonstration I
referred to above the Police
shot in the air and then
used tear bonds to stop
the demonstration.

I honestly believe that
these parades that
Suther King organ-

izes ~~do~~ ³ more to hurt the
negroes than it does to
help them.

As I mentioned above
I was in sympathy with
the negroes to get Equality
but these marches they
have in my opinion does
not help what they are
fighting for. Most of
their marches end in
violence and looting
such as the march in
Watts where the Negroes
looted stores and set
fires which ran into
millions of dollars.
