It seems to me that groups now should be represented by some head rather than mob rule and this is what we have and which is being sanctioned, directly or indirectly, by those who don't realize the consequences.


How can an individual meet mob rule when they are throwing rocks, Molotov cocktails and any other weapon at hand, without regard to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.
