
Dear Mayor Allen:

Attached is a copy of my reply to a "fact Sheet" being circulated by the firemen's union, of which you are no doubt aware of.

There are many areas I do not agree with your philosophy, but I do not agree with the firemen's union in regard to the strike which kept Atlanta in an extremely vulnerable state either. The city handled the situation very well and if you were to be subject to criticism, it would be due to your leniency to the strikers. As I stated in my reply, I will back our firemen now on duty and if a raise in pay will attract better men, I am in favor of such a move.

It is my hope that the majority of Atlantans will express similar views regarding this so-called fact sheet being circulated.
