Dear Gerald:

Thank you very much for your brief note of October 24th inquiring as to information on the request for travel expenses submitted to your office in the amount of \$165.50 covering a trip to Fayette, Mississippi by Miss Jimmie Mims, the Deputy Director of Recreation.

Mr. Dan Sweat, of the Mayor's Office, has been contacted by a planning firm in Washington who is assisting at this time Mayor Evers of Fayette, Mississippi, in improving community facilities and services in his town. I believe that Mayor Evers is the first and only black Mayor in all of Mississippi--I may be incorrect about that--but at any rate Mr. Sweat feels that the City should render all possible assistance wherever we can. Accordingly, at my request, Miss Mims has expressed her willingness to travel to Fayette, Mississippi and make on-the-spot recommendations for recreation and park facilities and to review proposals that have already been drawn up by the city of Fayette. I subsequently submitted to your office the request for travel expenses so Miss Mims could make this trip sometime in the near future.
